

Dealing with Doubts

John 20:19-29

1. What were some of the reasons that led Thomas to doubt the resurrection of Jesus?

- a. Being alone instead of with the other 10 disciples
- b. Having a negative personality
- c. Refusing to believe the testimony of the other disciples
- 2. How did Jesus respond to the doubts of Thomas?
- a. Jesus appeared to the disciples a second time when Thomas was present.
 - $\ensuremath{\text{b.}}$ Jesus invited Thomas to touch the scars of the cross.
- c. Thomas responded in faith by saying: "My Lord and my God."
- 3. How does this story of Thomas encourage us today?
 - a. God doesn't abandon you when you have doubts.
 - b. The Christian faith can withstand intense scrutiny.
 - c. After all the evidence is in, it still requires faith.
- d. We too must examine the evidence and respond by saying with Thomas: "My Lord and my God."
