Dear LifeWise Supporters,

We wanted you to hear about our community support and involvement in Morocco. The town of Morocco holds BEAVER FEST over the Memorial Day weekend and hosts a number of events from Saturday through Memorial Day. Two years ago we had an entry in the parade and passed out info about LifeWise coming to Morocco in the fall. We also had a booth with free Children's Bibles and a craft for the children. Last year we set up a booth where the community gathers for fireworks on Sunday night and we passed out glow sticks to all the kids.

Last summer we supported the children and families of Morocco by bringing in the Silly Safari program from Indianapolis for an afternoon of fun and games for the children—about 100 children were present for the Silly Safari program that explicitly displayed the beauty of God's creation through the many exotic animals they brought with them, and gave God the credit for His creation.

This year we heard that the town had no sponsor for the 5K Hustle and they needed an organization to fill the gap. Since my wife, Heidi, has participated in this race in the past (and many other races), as well as directing a race, the LifeWise Board discussed the advantages of stepping up to help Morocco and its families with this activity. Our Board was concerned that it was being held on a Sunday morning, but when they found out that there was a Community Worship service for Morocco in the town park after the race as part of the tradition, we decided we could show that LifeWise was dedicated to serving this community and show that support to the larger Morocco community in the process. We will have a booth with LifeWise material to share and hope to have some of our students participate as well—handing out water and snacks along the route—letting them **Serve** (one of the Biblical character qualities we teach them)!
